HOT BUILDINGS

The Union Square Lofts (333 W. Hubbard St.), Kingsbury on the Park (653 N. Kingsbury St.) and Erie on the Park (500 W. Erie St.) all attract single men of a certain age. Others rent at the hip, South Beach-inspired stunner EnV (161 W. Kinzie St.). But the most exclusive bachelor lair may be the 25-row house City Club on a half-square block bounded by Huron, Kingsbury and Superior, thanks to the spacious layouts (3,000–4,500 square feet) and two- or three-car garages.
